It's unique in its ability to handle digital and analog images solely or together. It includes an image browser that reads, writes, imports and exports metadata, HTML:generator and a state-of-the-art labeler for analog images.

StockView has links with InView's Contacts and Receivables files. The Catalogue has a special export format for searchLynx™, HindSight's image library for web sites.

StockView can catalogue and research photographs, digital images, designs, illustrations, locations, art forms, anything you have a whole lot of.

StockView is fully up to date with the latest in metadata reading and writing and with PLUS licensing. These are rapidly changing technologies so updates are issued with some frequency.

A high resolution printer, such as a laser printer is a must to print bar coded labels. Dot matrix cannot print the fine resolution required. Ink jet printers produce marginal results and a high rate of mis-reading.

The StockView files are programmed to look for one another by name and location. All StockView files must all be together in one folder with their original names. Do not move or change the names of any files.
